Having a rich mixture of cultures in Singapore means that there's always a cultural event to celebrate, all throughout the year. Being a culturally open and sensitive society, Singapore has managed to acquire a unique identity while still retaining the various groups' traditional practices, customs and festivals.

This issue of Festivals depicts 4 of these major festivals, namely: **Chinese New Year**, **Hari Raya Puasa**, **Deepavali** and **Christmas**. In addition, look out for the Special Collector's Sheet which features all the 8 stamp designs, which is printed with special foiling technique.

Chinese New Year

Most important of the traditional Chinese holidays, the Chinese New Year ushers in the new lunar year. The mood of celebrations will continue for 15 days, with the exuberant Chingay Procession rounding up as the close of the festive season.

Hari Raya Puasa

An important religious day of the year for Muslims in Singapore, Hari Raya Puasa is celebrated at the end of Ramadan, the Muslim month of fasting and alms-giving.

Deepavali

Deepavali, also known as "Festival of Lights", is much celebrated worldwide and for Hindus and Sikhs in Singapore. On this day, Hindus traditionally light rows of oil lamps to thank the gods and to usher in all that's good.

Christmas

Christmas is the commemoration of the birth of Jesus Christ, and is celebrated throughout the Christian population as well as many non-Christians as a secular, cultural festival. Modern customs of the holiday eventually evolved, with gift-giving and Church celebrations.

Tze Ngan's Story

(Tze Ngan is the designer for the latest Festivals stamp issue)

As a fervent collector, my interest in stamps is nurtured since young. Whenever I look at my collection, it never fails to transport me back to the nostalgic memory lanes! Each stamp issue unfolds a story, all encompassing around the thumb size platform. It's my great honour to be part of the stamp design team for the past years, since designing has been my profession. This has no doubt fuelled my passion for stamps in a different way. The process of designing stamps is as important as any design projects. Although stamp designing is truly a long process, but I am always and truly enlightened by the interesting knowledge obtained whenever I do the extensive research on the relevant themes.

The most recent stamp issue, 'Festivals', that I designed, featured symbolic motifs of each culture, of our multiracial country. The celebratory mood of each festival is further enhanced by the vibrant colours of each race with a consistent colour – gold. Mesmerised by the wonders and glitteries of the festive seasons, it has inspired me

to use different foil stamping to encapsulate the essence. This definitely challenged the printing technique, as foiling has always been very difficult on intricate details, and because of the numerous technical limitations, I find myself working very closely with the printer, to ensure the achievement of foil is of optimum effect on each stamp design. I am so glad that the Philatelic & Stamps department and the printer shared the same vision as myself and were very supportive to make the desired end product a reality!

I appreciate the chance to work on this issue and look forward to work on more in the near future. I hope you like my work.

Olympism, Transportation, Nature, Culture and Singapore – these were some of the interesting themes at the National Stamp Collecting Competition (NSSC) 2010. This year, 700 students from primary and secondary schools, and tertiary institutions took part in the stamp competition that seeks to promote the study of postage stamps and philatelic materials to learn about the world. The winning entries were exhibited from 03 to 05 September 2010 at the National Library, Singapore.

NSSC 2010 is the tenth year that students could submit philatelic entries in the “School Group Category”. Students work in groups of four to submit an entry using stamps, philatelic items and narratives to explore a topic of their choice. The entries are judged by a panel of experienced judges from the Association of Singapore Philatelists, and participants win Gold, Silver and Bronze awards.

The School Group category was introduced in 2001 as part of the ‘Singpex’ competition to encourage student participation. Then, the

exhibition of entries could be housed at the Singapore Philatelic Museum. As the number of philatelic entries submitted by students increased each year, the venue of the exhibition moved to bigger locations such shopping centres, and to the National Library in recent years. To date, about 3,500 students have taken part in the category.

This year, an exciting second phase of NSSC through “Community Curate! Project” sponsored by the Ministry of Information, and the Arts, will allow the public to decide the ten most popular NSSC entries that will be put on display at Singapore Philatelic Museum from December 2010 to March 2011. This is the first time that members of the public will have the opportunity to decide what will be displayed in an exhibition at a National Heritage Board museum. Look out for the top 30 NSSC entries that will be posted online from October to November 2010 to vote for your favourite entries!

NSSC 2010 was proudly organised by the Singapore Philatelic Museum with the support from the Singapore Post Limited, Ministry of Education, Association of Singapore Philatelists, stamp clubs and National Library Board.

General Information

1. A 7% GST is payable on all postal stationery and philatelic products such as presentation packs, miniature sheets and annual collections purchased in Singapore.
2. Overseas customers who place mail orders with the Singapore Philatelic Bureau need not pay GST.
3. All orders are accepted subject to availability of stocks. Where orders cannot be met, refunds will be made less the appropriate commission charge.
4. Stamps are supplied in mint or cancelled-to-order (CTO) condition, if requested. The normal Singapore Philatelic Bureau metal circular datestamp will be used on the CTO stamps.
5. All mail orders for philatelic products (excluding Annual Collections and Premium Gifts) are subject to a handling charge as follows:

Destination	Handling Charge
Singapore	S\$0.50 per order
Brunei Darussalam/Malaysia	S\$0.80 per order
Overseas	S\$1.80 per order

Please add S\$2.24 if you require registration service within Singapore or add \$2.20 for Brunei Darussalam/Malaysia/Overseas. Customers who also order Annual collections need not pay the registration fee. The Singapore Philatelic Bureau will absorb all GST payable for the registration fee and handling charge.

6. Customers who order Annual Collections and Premium Gifts are required to pay an additional handling charge as follows:

Brunei Darussalam/Malaysia	S\$8.00 per order
Overseas (by airmail)	S\$15.00 per order

All orders will be sent by registered post.
