Festive Postage Rates for Deepavali

Singapore, 30 September 2003 - Singapore Post (SingPost) today announced its festive postage rates for the upcoming festival, Deepavali.

With immediate effect, the public can post greeting cards for Deepavali using the special festive postage rates, thereby benefiting from the convenience and savings in postage.

Local Greeting Cards

From now until 24 October 2003, the postage for a Deepavali festive greeting card of any size, shape and colour is 22 cents for weight up to 20 gm and 30 cents for weight up to 40 gm.

For greeting cards beyond 40 gm in weight, the Normal Standard Large and Non-Standard Rates continue to apply (Please see Annex 1 for Local Mail Rates).

Greeting Cards Posted For Delivery Overseas

The festive postage rate for a Deepavali greeting card weighing up to 40 gm posted to anywhere in the world is 50 cents. Deepavali greeting cards to Malaysia and Brunei will be charged the postage rates of 40 cents (for weight up to 20 gm) and 50 cents (for weight up to 50 gm).
