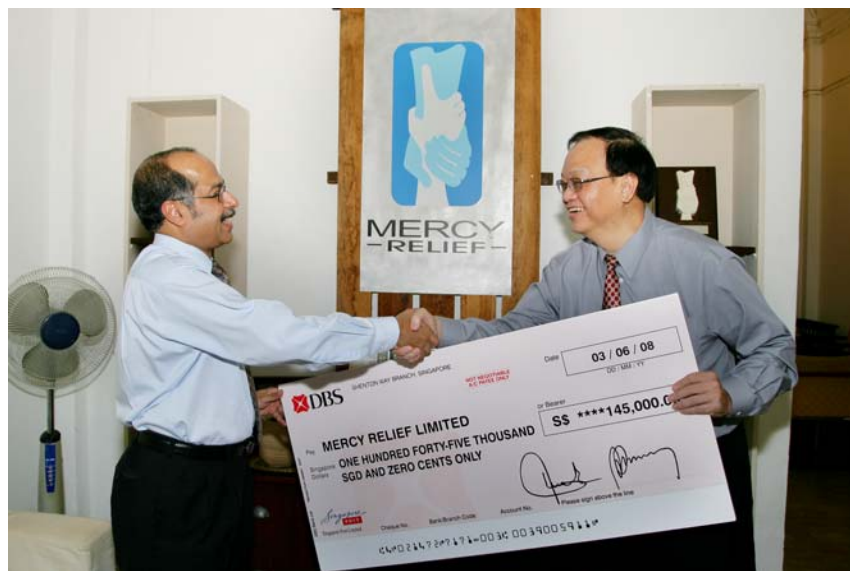

Singapore, 6 June 2008 – Singapore Post Limited (SingPost) today presented a cheque for S\$145,000 to Mercy Relief Limited towards humanitarian aid for disaster-stricken Myanmar and China. SingPost continues to facilitate public donations

To facilitate public donations, SingPost has been leveraging its wide distribution network of post offices and Self-service Automated Machines (SAMs), for collections for both Mercy Relief Limited and the Singapore Red Cross Society.

> **Public donations at Post Offices**

The public can donate at any of SingPost's 62 post offices through donation tins placed at the counters. The donation drive ends on 15 June 2008 and the funds raised goes towards Mercy Relief Limited's relief efforts for the victims in China.

> **Electronic donations via SAMs**

Members of the public can also donate via the over 250 Self-service Automated Machines (SAMs) conveniently located across the island. The donations go towards Singapore Red Cross Society's China and Myanmar relief funds and the donation drive lasts till 14 June 2008 and 16 June 2008 respectively.

> **Postage waiver for cheque donations**

Since 15 May 2008, SingPost also waived the postage for cheque donations to Mercy Relief Limited or Singapore Red Cross Society. Senders simply need to state either 'Mercy Relief Limited' or 'Singapore Red Cross Society' on the sealed envelope and drop it into any of SingPost's 800 post boxes.
