- Printed Papers include but are not limited to paper based items like annual reports, books, catalogues, direct mail, newspapers or periodicals with no commercial value.
- Mail and packages sent via Tracked services must not exceed the maximum dimensions of 324mm x 229mm x 65mm and maximum weight of 500g for mail/2kg for packages. Additional surcharge may apply for oversized and/or overweight items.
- For posting of bulky parcels larger than 600mm x 400mm x 300mm but L+2W+2H within 3m (max length 1.5m) and weight within 30kg, Speedpost delivery rate of \$12.15 will apply.

SingPost will be raising postage, package delivery as well as doorstep parcel delivery rates from 1 January 2023 due to overall cost increase. This is in tandem with the exceptional inflationary cost increases across manpower, fuel and electricity, as well as the increase in Goods and Services Tax (GST).

Similarly, on 1 Jan 2024, postage rates will be adjusted. More information will be provided in due course.
